Faculty is the most important person in curriculum design, implementation and development, feedback from faculty on curricular aspects are of utmost importance.

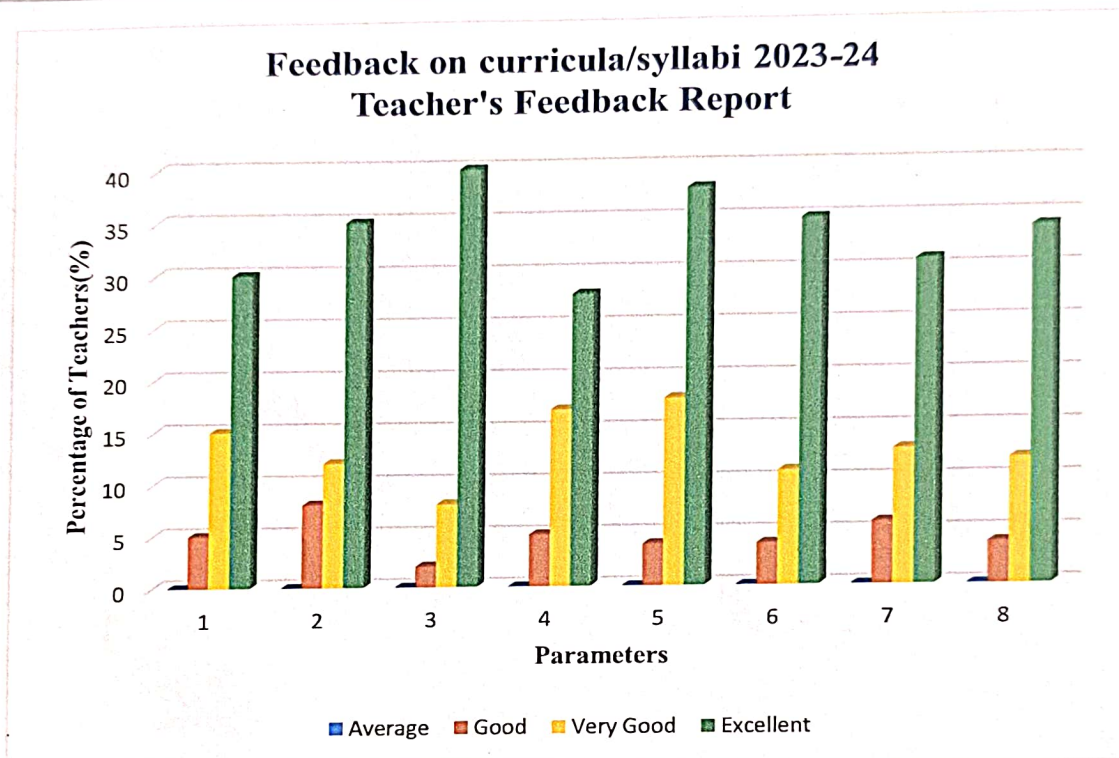
Teacher's feedback is collected individually.
